To be eligible for the above Sale Races, eligible horses will need to be paid up for each year's race to compete in the following year/s.

The First Acceptance Fee and the Nomination Fees set out below are due to be paid to the Rockhampton Jockey Club (RJC) by close of business on the dates specified.

This year we will trial a special discounted fee of \$1450.00 plus GST offered as an inclusive payment for all three races set out below if paid to the RJC office by close of trade Friday 17th May 2019. THIS FEE WILL BE DISCOUNTED TO \$1200 PLUS GST IF PAID AT THE SALE ON SUNDAY 14TH APRIL 2019.

2020 2YO Race

First Acceptance Fee of \$1000 plus GST..... Due Friday 17rd May 2019

Discounted First Acceptance Fee \$800 plus GST..... Due Sunday 14th April 2019

Final Acceptance Fee will be due to Racing Queensland as per their standard conditions.

2021 3 & 4YO Race

Nomination Fee of \$300 plus GST Due Friday 2nd October 2020

2022 3 & 4YO Race

Nomination Fee of \$300 plus GSTDue Friday 1st October 2021

Should first acceptors for the 2020 2YO Race not reach a minimum of 70 horses then the RJC reserves the right to reduce the prizemonies for the 2020 2YO race by \$1000 for each acceptance less than seventy first acceptors. 2021 and 2022 3&4YO races to be reduced by \$500 for each first acceptance less than 70.
